

INFORMATION ON PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA OF PEOPLE CONTACTING PAK-PCE POLSKI AUTOBUS WODOROWY SP. Z O.O.

Who will be processing the personal data and how to contact the entity

1. **PAK-PCE Polski Autobus Wodorowy Sp. z o.o.** (hereinafter “**the Company**”) based in Konin, registered office address: ul. Kazimierska 45, 62-510 Konin, is the controller of personal data in the meaning of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (“GDPR”). All requests, declarations as well as any correspondence regarding personal data protection shall be addressed in writing to the above mentioned address of the Company’s registered office, or by e-mail to the following address biuro@polskiautobuswodorowy.pl.

Goals and legal basis of personal data processing

3. Providing of your personal data is not a statutory obligation, but it is indispensable to enable handling of requests and providing replies.
4. Personal data shall be processed:
 - a) in order to perform the Company’s legitimate interests, such as handling requests addressed to the Company and providing replies, handling civil and enforcement proceedings, administrative, criminal proceedings, handling internal processes related to carrying out of statutory proceedings – pursuant to Article 6 item 1 f of GDPR,
 - b) in order to fulfill the legal obligations - pursuant to Article 6 item 1 c of GDPR.

With whom the data will be shared

5. Your personal data can be shared with the following categories of recipients: entities providing services to the controller which are required for the accomplishment of the above mentioned objectives, including IT partners, , parties providing technical or organizational support, other sub-contractors in the area of customer service, parties authorized to obtain the data by virtue of the law.
6. Personal data may be transferred to countries/international organizations outside the European Economic Area, if such countries/organizations – based on the decision of the European Commission – have been regarded as having the level of personal data protection which is adequate to the level of protection valid on the territory of the European Economic Area or provided that the appropriate safeguards are applied which may consist in binding corporate rules, standard personal data protection clauses adopted by the President of the Personal Data Protection Office or contractual clauses permitted by the President of the Personal Data Protection, and their copies may be obtained at the request filed according to the procedure mentioned in item 1 above.

Time for which the data will be subject to processing

7. Personal data will be processed until completion of the handling of a request, and then for the period of limitation of claims and until the completion of any civil law, debt enforcement, administrative and criminal proceedings which require processing of such data.

Rights in respect of personal data processing

8. You have the right to access your data, correct the data, have the data deleted, restrict data processing as well as transfer the data provided to the controller.
9. You have the right to object against data processing for the purposes realized by virtue of the controller's or third party's legitimate interest, including profiling, for reasons associated with your particular situation and to object against data processing for the direct marketing purposes, including profiling.
10. The above requests and declarations shall be filed in the manner indicated in 1 above.

Where to file a complaint regarding personal data processing

11. A complaint regarding processing of your personal data may be filed with the supervising authority which deals with personal data protection. The President of the Personal Data Protection Office is the supervising authority in the Republic of Poland.

Automated decision-making (including profiling)

12. No automated decision-making (including profiling) will be performed as regards your personal data.
